Parish Outing to Milestones, 28th September

This year's Parish Outing on Saturday 28th September is a visit to the Milestones Museum at Basingstoke. Milestones Museum of Living History is made up of a network of streets that have been recreated according to those found in Victorian and 1930s Hampshire. From cobbled streets to vintage vehicles, a 1940s sweet shop to a penny arcade, and even a pub! there is lots of interest and nostalgia to enjoy. To keep the costs down we are planning to get there by car, sharing transport – passengers pay £5 towards petrol to their driver. The cost of entry to the museum is £15 (£13 Concessions – Senior Citizens)and if we buy the tickets on-line we will get a 15% discount. The tickets are valid for a return visit any time over the following year. There is a list at the back of church, please put your name down on it as soon as possible if you are coming, indicating if you can provide or need transport, we can then organise the transport and the tickets and all meet up at the museum for a great day out.


