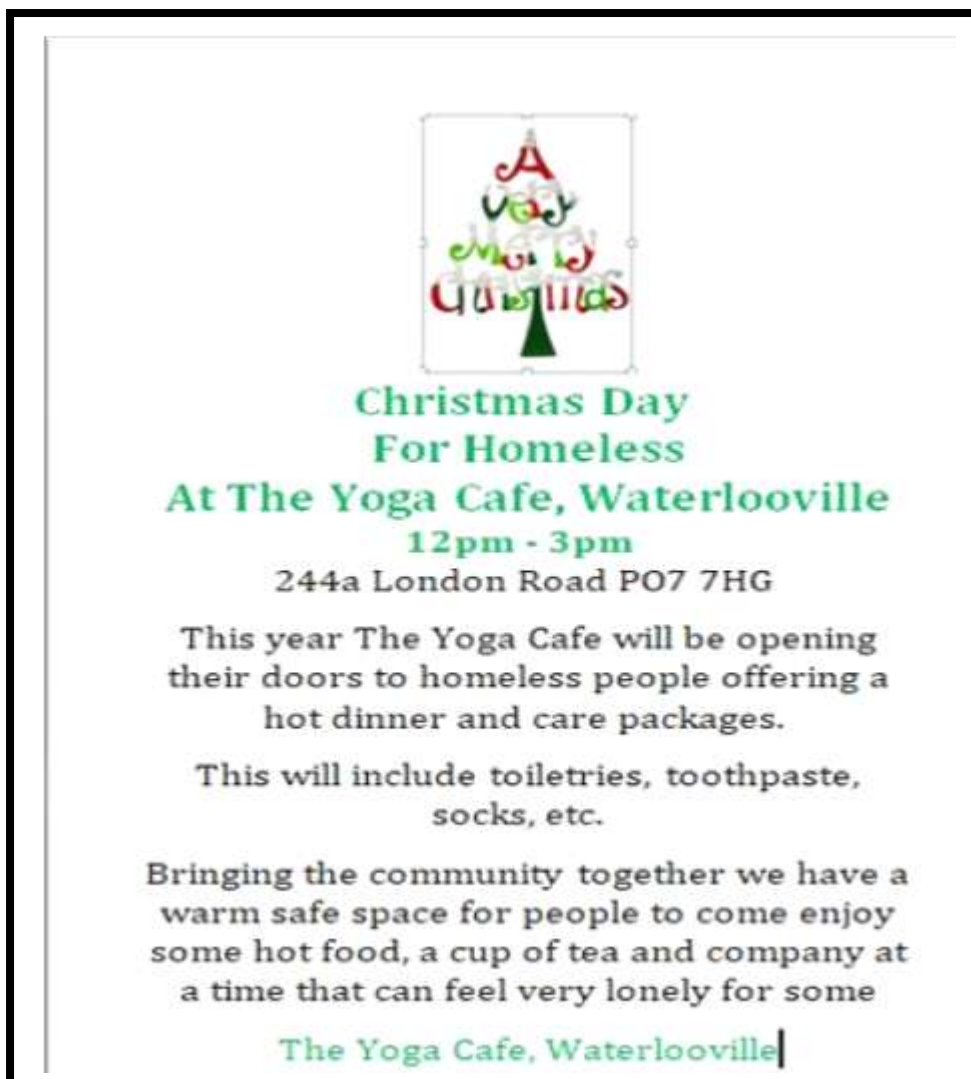
HATS Pantomime
