Remembrance Sunday is held in the United Kingdom as a day "to commemorate the contribution of British and Commonwealth military and civilian servicemen and women in the two World Wars and later "conflicts." A moment of silence is held at 11am for two minutes followed by the last post. Monday 11th November: Short service with laying of wreaths and two minutes silence for Armistice Day, beginning at the Lych Gate at 10:45.

### **Kidney Research – the retiring collection this month**

Kidney Research UK is a charity that funds research that focuses on the prevention, treatment and management of kidney disease. The charity was founded in 1961 with the stated aim to improve patient care and raise awareness of kidney disease.

Children can experience many forms of kidney disease from before birth to when they transition into adulthood, and are affected by acute kidney injury, anaemia, cardiovascular consequences of kidney insufficiency, glomerular and tubular abnormalities. Research is crucial to improve the outlook and quality of care for children with renal conditions.
