What is Christingle?

Now in its 51st year, Christingle is a special, memorable celebration that takes place in thousands of churches and schools across the country



The celebration is named after the Christingles that are lit during the service. Christingles are made from an orange decorated with red tape, fruits and a candle. With your help, Christingle raises vital funds to help children who are facing Christmas alone and are unable to cope.

Your Christingle celebration is an opportunity to bring your whole community together, to share the Christian story and to experience the joy and wonder of this well-loved Christmas tradition.

The Symbolism of Christingle



Each element of a Christingle has a special meaning and helps to tell the Christian story:



- The orange represents the world.
 - The red ribbon (or tape) symbolises the love
 - of Christ.
 - The sweets and dried fruit represent
- all of God's

and blood

- Creations.
- The lit candle represents Jesus's light

in the world,

bringing hope to people living in darkness.


