## A Message from Fr Colin re Church Opening

I am sure that like myself you will all be delighted that from Wednesday 2nd December we can come together as a community of faith for public worship. On that day I will celebrate the Eucharist in the main body of the church, and hope that many of you will be able to join with me. Of course, there are restrictions on us, very much the same as before. You will need to book a place for each service by emailing me on <a href="mailto:parishpriest@stgeorges.church">parishpriest@stgeorges.church</a> or by ringing the Parish Office on 02392 258079 and leaving a message. As before your temperature will need to be taken as you enter the church, and you will be asked to sanitise your hands. You will also be required to wear a face covering. Numbers will be limited, and you will need to be socially distant from those outside of your household or bubble.

The Eucharist will be celebrated at 8AM and 10 AM every Sunday and at 10AM on a Wednesday from the end of the lockdown on Wednesday 2nd December. Both the 10 AM Sunday and Wednesday services will continue to be livestreamed.

#### **Christmas Services**

Given the restrictions it is unlikely that we will be able to have all of our usual Christmas services, and we might have to be creative in the way we will use livestreaming for additional services. More details will follow.

#### **Tier Two**

You will be aware that at the moment the whole of Hampshire (excluding the Isle of Wight) has been put into Tier Two. From the perspective of our church services the additional tier two restrictions state that we can meet for worship, but people should not socialise with those outside of their household. This is very much the same as before. Similarly weddings with no more than 15 guests can take place, as can funerals (with a limit of 30). There are, of course, further restrictions for non-worship activities, which I am sure you are aware of.

I will make sure you are kept updated as things become clearer. Love and prayers Fr Colin
