A Pastoral Message from Fr Colin - The Bishop has confirmed that churches can remain open for the purpose of public worship. Our risk assessment has been updated to reflect the changing situation. Please continue to observe the protocols that we have had in place throughout the pandemic, making sure that you put your mask on before you enter the church, have your temperature taken, sanitise your hands, and observe the two-metre rule where possible. As you leave the church, leave your service book on your seat so that it can be removed and quarantined, and leave the building quickly and in an orderly fashion. Do not congregate at the back of the church for a chat. Let us do all we can to keep each other as safe as possible. **Please do not enter the church for any reason other than public worship.** If it is necessary to come into the church for the purpose of essential maintenance then please let me or the wardens know, so that it can be recorded should it be needed for the purpose of track and trace. Thank you for your understanding.

Fr Arthur Green - Many of you will remember Fr Arthur Green who had helped out at St George's in the past, particularly during interregnum. Sadly, Fr Arthur died on 29th December. His funeral will be on 26th January. During the current pandemic it will not be possible for people other than family to attend. However, Fr Arthur's son is going to let us have a link to a livestream of the service which we will let you have when it is available.
