Today is Trinity Sunday. The concept of the Trinity is very difficult for many Christians to understand and I suspect that many people simply choose not to think too much about it. The various parts of the teaching about the Trinity are not hard to comprehend. We are able to think about God the creator, and about God coming to live among us as a human being, and about the God whom we experience in our lives. In that sense we can perhaps cope with the ideas of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. I think we can also cope with the idea of there being one God only. Our problem comes if we try to put these ideas together. This will be explored in our Sunday homily.
